The Corrective Action Engineering Section and Division of Hydrogeology of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) have completed the review of the above referenced document, which was received by the Department on June 9, 2006. The purpose of this Record of Decision (ROD) is to formalize the remedy for SWMUs 2 and 15.


The investigation for SWMUs 2 and 15 included test pitting operations as well as the collection of surface soil, subsurface soil, and groundwater samples. The result of the baseline human health risk assessment concluded that the human health exposure is within the U.S EPA's acceptable risk range. Furthermore, the ecological risk assessment concluded that there is no significant potential risk to terrestrial and aquatic receptors.

The Proposed Plan for SWMUs 2 and 15 was public noticed on August 11, 2000. A public information session was held on August 24, 2000 to explain the proposed remedy and solicit comments. No comments were received regarding to the proposed remedy.

The Department has deemed that the No Further Action (NFA) determination is appropriate, is protective of human health and the environment, and satisfies the RCRA corrective action requirements of Section VI of the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) effective March 31, 2006. Consequently, the Department concurs with this ROD. Please be advised that this determination is based upon currently available data. Additional investigation may be necessary in the future should information become available warranting such action.
