Please find attached a figure that delineates the areas of archaeological concern. Unfortunately, the entire area is of archaeological interest. As we move forward, MCRD will coordinate with the State Historic Preservation Officer regarding site activities.

Below is a brief description of the site:

The map shows the boundary of the archaeological site in a transparent yellow. Everything within that shaded area is part of the eligible site. The entire project site (Motor Transport Facility) lies within a known eligible archaeological site, the only portions which have not been physically surveyed are those underneath pavement, but as the site surrounds the pavement, the paved areas are included as it's safe to assume the site goes under the pavement. The southern half of the shaded area is a known cemetery. As it stands, the project zone appears to be bordering, but not intruding into, the cemetery. As long as the project zone doesn't cross the current fencing around the cemetery, it should be safe from impacting burials.
