**SUBJ: EPA Review of the Change Page submittal of the Draft Final FY08 Site Management Plan (SMP)  
(Reed cover letter dated February 19, 2008; document dated 17 January, 2008).**

Dear Sirs:

The revised Draft Final FY08 Site Management Plan (SMP) was not submitted by the requested due date of January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008, and therefore EPA's conditional approval became null and void on that date, necessitating this letter. Furthermore, EPA's review of the revised FY08 SMP submitted on February 1, 2008 has revealed that one of EPA's conditions does not appear to have been met. Condition 4 was identified as follows:

4. Ensure SCDHEC's comments are addressed in your changes and submit those resulting change pages by January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008.

There does not appear to be any changes made to address SCDHEC's November 30, 2007 comments. EPA is unsure if this is due to them not being addressed, or due to the

Navy's/MCRD's conclusion that their resolution did not require a change page. Further review of SCDHEC's comments, coupled with a discussion with the SCDHEC RPM, revealed that change pages may or may not still be needed. Since it appears the majority of SCDHEC's comments could be resolved in the first draft of the FY09 SMP, due to be submitted in June of 2008, EPA has decided to approve this SMP based on the current submittal, with an expectation that SCDHEC's comments be addressed in the first draft of the FY09 SMP, as appropriate. However, if it is determined by SCDHEC and the Navy/MCRD that additional change pages are required for this FY08 SMP, EPA will need to review and approve any changes made to the document as submitted on February 1, 2008.

EPA appreciates the coordination efforts put forth by the Base and Navy in developing an improved Site Management Plan, and looks forward to making even more improvements in the FY09 SMP. If there are any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at (404) 562-9969 about this approval.
