I guess I would expect to see a list that includes all of these, and talk about which ones to keep on or take off, if we are pursuing a "Sediments OU" approach, although, again, that does not leave out the other media, to be investigated as appropriate. Then when we get the list narrowed once, thinking sediments, then we can narrow again if need be for funding reasons, etc. And then take the last list and identify status = PA needed? SI needed? Extended SI needed? RI needed? And attack the PA needed sites first, as far as SAP/QAPs go, if that still makes sense once we've reworked the list.

Site 14 background info

Hi folks,

I was trying to id docs to start reviewing for background info on Site 14 Outfalls. I could not find anything for Site 14, other than what is in the SMP. Interestingly, it says funds are anticipated for an RI/FS, however, it does not reference any findings from a PA/SI. Maybe I missed something, or maybe it is lumped in with another group of Site PA/SI's. I have seen other references to an 1986 IAS, which is supposedly a PA equivalent. Would this have included all these "other" sites. Could someone please direct me to, and/or send me, the appropriate background document, whatever it is?

Also, I am awaiting the list of Sites with potential sediment impact to be grouped together with Site 14. I know we mentioned 21, 54, and Elliot's Beach.

But what else? 4? 5? 13c? 35 - for the creek area (or is that too much of a stretch to justify lumping) ? I have the CS/SI for these.

What about 50 - or is this one a range covered by a currently active range? What about the other MMRP sites? With this sediment OU or separate?

I guess we ruled out 53 as being big enough, and far enough away from the marsh, to be it's own OU.

I have no info on 39, 46, 47, 48, 49, or 52. Did I miss anything? I at least need a map of these.....

Mark/Charles/Heber, can you get me other background docs/info?
