Hi Charles, and others,

I do need to clarify immediately, that ANY activity at the site in which contaminants are to be encountered, or ANY activities which could in some way impact the site (such as drilling through confining layers, building structures, demolishing structures, drawing waters, etc), even if contaminants are not to be encountered directly, needs to be approved by the regulators. Now, having said that, the degree to which review and comment is implemented depends on the nature of each activity, and the purpose/objectives. For this work, FIELD WORK IS NOT TO BEGIN UNTIL APPROVAL IS RECEIVED BY EPA. (I cannot speak for SCDHEC.)

In this case, we obviously have impact to the site, exposure to contaminants, etc., but I also thought previous communications regarding this project had indicated that some of this data may be referenced or used in evaluating alternatives, and perhaps even implementing the selected remedy(ies). So EPA will be reviewing and commenting on the plan. We will mostly be looking at impact to the site, protectiveness of the workers, but we also need VERY CLEAR OBJECTIVES from the Navy/MCRD if any of this data is to be used and/or referenced in our site work. If the plan is not reviewed up front with specific objectives regarding our site work as a result of this data gathering activity, and the Navy/MCRD wishes to later decide to use the data, the data may not be accepted by EPA. Please clarify.

ALSO, please include all team members on your communications. Once again, Mac and Sommer appear to be left off, as well as Don Vroblecky. I do not have all these addresses at home. Could someone please forward to those left off. I will copy Mac here.
