Hi Folks,

The RTCs attached hereto are acceptable, but you still need to get the language changes accurately reflected in the revised SAP for it to be approved. In the past we have had issues with RTCs not getting transferred accurately into the revised document. So please proceed with caution.

Field work can proceed without finalization of the document provided all technical changes have been provided to and discussed with the field crew and labs.

As a final reminder, if the need arises in the field to propose any changes to the SAP other than those already addressed in the Draft SAP as a potential modification, the issues should be discussed with the Parris Island Team before approval, if at all possible.
