Review of Abandonment of Free Product Recovery/Siphon Tube Well, Building 4022, Marine Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD), Parris Island, South Carolina dated September 2010 (Received October 2010)

The above referenced document has been reviewed with respect to the conditions of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) that the Department entered into with the Navy and EPA Region 4 in January 2005. The Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) granted a No Further Action (NFA) status to Building 4022 (Former 550 Gallon Fuel Oil Underground Storage Tank) in July 2008 (Bishop to Harrington). When SCDHEC granted NFA status, it also approved a request to abandon all monitoring wells at Building 4022. However, during abandonment activities, a free-product recovery well was not abandoned at that time. Therefore, MCRD is requesting approval from the Department to abandon this recovery well. Abandonment of this well is scheduled for November 2010 in accordance with regulations (R.61-71.H.2.e)

Based on review of this report, the Department approves the abandonment request of the free product recovery well.
