Hi team,

The Department needs to know where the SI/CS discussion falls in relation to other priorities at MCRD. I do not believe that it was listed on the FY 2011 schedule that we laid out in November. If it is not one of the very top, we will not be prepared to discuss in the March meeting, as this discussion will take much preparation from the team. The Navy is required to rework the schedule based on the conditional approval of the SMP and also the additional documents/items that will require review based on our Jan 19 Site 3 meeting. Until Site 3 items arrive, the Department will be reviewing the Site 5 RI/FS WP D1, which was the next on Navy priority based on the schedule we set out in November. However, please remember the Department is not held to the end of February review date because of the required reworking of the schedule.

Also FYI, some of you may get this email twice, but I wanted to make sure everyone on our agreed upon email listing got the email. Please remember to include Stacey on all team emails. This will become especially important when I'm out for maternity leave!
