Subject: Claire's feedback on the posters

Hi folks,

I just heard from Claire. She looked over the posters with a perspective of one who is not as knowledgeable about the Site timeline as the rest of us, much like the public will be. And she noticed there is a disconnect between the IROD actions and the PP. We sort of jump

straight to the proposed Plan, then back track to the Fish Study, without explaining what happened in between, and why we are talking about it out of order. We are thinking we need some sort of time line to bridge that gap. Maybe we could use an arrow type timeline that shows the IROD, then the first round of Post-remedial sediment samples, then second round post remedial samples, then the fish tissue estimates from sediment concentrations, then the fish tissue sampling, then the PP. I don't know whether this would be a separate slide, or if you could squeeze it in above where you start talking about the PP, or what. Or if we are reluctant to point out how much time elapsed in between, we could just have a list of "Series of Events leading from the IROD to the Proposed Plan in sequence." Lists just take more poster space.
