The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed review of the request for extension for Site 45 RI/FS D2 submittal to be extended to April 30, 2012 pursuant to the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA). The Navy's request for extension is approved as follows:

- Approved: Site 45 RI/FS D2 Deadline Extension to April 30, 2012.

In accordance with the FFA any extension requests should indicate the impact each extension will have on other milestones associated with the site. Since there is no mention of impact to other milestones EPA expects other milestones associated with these sites will be met in accordance with the most recently approved milestone dates. Submittal of the Draft Final documents by the adjusted deadline milestone dates is enforceable as specified by the FFA. These deadlines can only be extended again based on a written extension request, not by submittal of a revised SMP document.
