The Division of Waste Management of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) completed the review of the *Site 8A PCB Spill Area Unauthorized Excavation letter* received May 2, 2013. The Department reviewed the letter with respect to applicable sections of the South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (SCHWMR) and appreciates the detailed explanation. The Department has concerns about the several unauthorized activities on Installation Restoration Sites in the past. However, the Department understands that the Depot has investigated and addressed the source of non-compliance. Once obtained please provide the soil and concrete sampling results, as well as the appropriate disposal manifests, to the Department.
