
Dear Mr. Owens and Mr. Harrington:

The Division of Waste Management of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) completed the review of the above document received September 19, 2013.

Based on the approval of the Site 14 SI Report, the Department believes that the Partnering Team should discuss the need for an RAO for Site 27 for its storm sewer and associated media. If LTM is to be completed for the storm sewer, then an RAO is necessary for the associated media. If the contamination at the storm sewer outfall is determined to be non-site related or below screening values, the RAO will become obsolete during the final Proposed Plan and ROD.
