Enclosure (1) contains a copy of the Site Management Plan for Naval Weapons Station (NWS) Yorktown, developed as required by the NWS Yorktown Federal Facility Agreement (FFA). The NWS Yorktown FFA, which was provided to your offices previously, is proposed as the model for developing an FFA for Portsmouth Naval Shipyard (PNS).

As we discussed after the March 14th Technical Review Committee (TRC) meeting, mid-April was proposed as a date to meet and discuss the development of a FFA for Portsmouth Naval Shipyard. Because of the difficulty scheduling all parties which will be involved in developing a FFA, I propose we set a date at the earliest possible time.

Enclosure (2) contains information describing the Relative Risk Site Evaluation program which we also discussed after the TRC meeting on March 14, 1995.
