
In response to your recent request, I have reviewed the information received August 15, 2002 to continue consultation on the above referenced project. This project is being reviewed pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended.

Based upon the findings stated in your letter of August 8, 2002, I concur with your determination that resources (archaeological) potentially eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places may be impacted by this project; I have also concluded that the procedures proposed (Phase 1B Archaeological Survey) will be sufficient and appropriate to make a Section 106 determination of effect for this project. We look forward to reviewing the Phase 1B archaeological work plan when it becomes available.

Additionally, I have determined that this project will have no adverse effect upon historic architectural resources.
