Munitions Response Site Prioritization for Naval Shipyard Portsmouth

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Mid-Atlantic, is updating the prioritization of the munitions response activities at NAVSHIPYD Portsmouth based on overall conditions at this location and taking into consideration safety and environmental hazards. The Navy is soliciting valuable public input on the prioritization process. The prioritization process will be discussed at the next Restoration Advisory Board meeting on **Tuesday, March 29, 2011, from 7:00-9:00 p.m., at the Town Hall in Kittery, Maine.**

Background

The Munitions Response Program addresses munitions and explosives of concern at ranges that are no longer operational and at such sites as munitions burial sites. A preliminary assessment of this installation was completed in 2005 and recommended one site for prioritization: the closed small arms range assigning an initial priority of 8 (lowest ranking possible for cleanup) for the range. The Navy recently revised the priority to reflect that no further action is required at this site.
