Thank-you for the Proposed Plan for OU-4 at the PNSY. Given that I likely have the longest tenure in addressing PNSY ecological impacts to the adjacent waters (1989 as a RCRA site), it is very satisfying to see the end of assessment and the start of remediation come into sight. This has been a long road traveled for many of us. I make note that this remedy takes into account the most serious ecological threats, and plans a remedy that will eliminate such. In fact, its a credit to the Navy and all who have worked on this site OU to see a comprehensive remedy that includes the most protective choices. And not lost is the fact that the Navy selected the most expensive of the remedies. I look forward to seeing a Record of Decision for this OU completed in the near future.
