The U.S. Navy proudly announces the signing of a Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit (OU) 7, which includes Site 32 - Topeka Pier Site at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, Kittery, Maine. The Navy and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency jointly signed the ROD in September 2013 with Maine Department of Environmental Protection concurrence. The ROD documents the selected remedy for OU7 under the federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA). The Selected Remedy for OU7 includes excavation of contaminated subsurface soil from two areas in the southeastern portion of the site to remove contamination based on potential industrial worker risks, implementation of land use controls (LUCs) via a LUC Remedial Design to prevent future potential residential exposure to contaminated material and future potential erosion of contaminated material to the offshore area, and five-year reviews to ensure the remedy remains protective of human health and the environment. The ROD also includes the Navy's responses to public comments received on the Proposed Plan.
