The Maine Department of Environmental Protection has completed its review of the subject document. The Department concurs with the No Further Action final remedy for Site 30. However, if additional information becomes available that indicates that hazardous material attributable to past operations at Building 184 remains on-site we expect the Navy to perform additional investigations there.

The State's concurrence of the selected remedy, as described above, should not be construed as the State's concurrence with any conclusion of law or finding of fact, which may be set forth in the Decision Document or supporting documents for Site 30. The State reserves any and all rights to challenge any such finding of fact or conclusion of law in any other context.
