Shares of Humana rally on silence

Humana has pulled out of a major health care conference and said it will not comment on rumors of a merger, actions that will likely fuel Wall Street speculation that the insurer is part of a developing deal.

Shares of the Medicare Advantage coverage provider, which hit an all-time high late last month, rose Monday while broader indexes slipped.

Humana said that it has received analyst and investor questions about its outlook and the possibility that it will "participate in industry consolidation."

The insurer said that as part of a long-standing policy it won't comment on speculation and that it will observe a quiet period that lasts until it announces second-quarter results July 29.
