1. This letter is provided to confirm execution responsibility for the Installation Restoration (IR) Program, at the subject Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEASYSKOM) facility as discussed during reference (a).

2. Atlantic Division, Naval Facility Engineering Command (LANTNAVFACENCOM) is requested to accept the lead for IR program management to continue the IR program at the Naval Industrial Reserve Ordnance Plant (NIROP) West Virginia as established by NAVSEASYSKOM. This program should be raised to priority 1 status to reflect inclusion of the facility on the National Priorities List.

3. LANTNAVFACENCOM must maintain a close interface with the major claimant, SEA 07I, in the execution of all IR Program requirements. All IR program decisions effecting NIROP facilities management will be jointly made by LANTNAVFACENCOM and NAVSEASYSKOM representatives.

4. Hercules Incorporated, the operating facilities contractor, has been proceeding with the Remedial Investigation phase of the IR Program with an appropriation under the reference (b) contract. Remaining contract funding should allow for completion of additional site definition and finalization of the IR Report. This will be the transition point to program management under Defense Environmental Restoration Act. Lead IR program transition to LANTNAVFACENCOM is targeted for 1 October 1993.
