A Proposed Plan for Operable Unit (OU) 4, Site 1 Soil, Allegany Ballistics Laboratory (ABL), Rocket Center, WV, Remedial Action is presently in a public comment period. The Proposed Plan identifies the Preferred Alternative for addressing human health and ecological risks at OU 4. As a result of historical activities at the site, OU-4 has been divided into two areas, identified as the Active Burning Ground (ABG) and the Outside Active Burning Ground (OABG). The Proposed Plan summarizes the remedial alternatives evaluated for each of these areas and provides the rationale for proposed selection of final remedial action for OU-4:

a. ABG: Excavation of areas of concern (AOCs), offsite disposal, land use controls (LUCs), and long-term management (LTM).

b. OABG: Removal of surface debris, excavation of AOCs, offsite disposal, LUCs, and LTM.

The Naval Facility Engineering Command Mid-Atlantic (NAVFAC MIDLANT) requests a list of applicable or relevant and appropriate requirements (ARARs) from the WV Department of Environmental Protection (WVDEP) within 30 working days of receipt of this request for any requirements that are applicable or relevant and appropriate to the Preferred Alternative outlined in the Proposed Plan. WVDEP may also communicate other pertinent advisories, criteria, or guidance to be considered (TBCs). The requested list should include a citation to the statute or regulation from which the requirement is derived.

The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) will be forwarding you a list of MDE ARARs and TBCs in approximately 30 calendar days. Upon receipt of the list of ARARs from MDE,

NAVFAC MIDLANT requests WVDEP consolidate the lists from both states, and submit the consolidated list to NAVFAC MIDLANT.
