



**Public Notice of
Change in the Scope of the
Response for Installation
Restoration Site 5,
Burning Grounds,
at St. Juliens Creek Annex,
Chesapeake, Virginia**

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC), Mid-Atlantic, is providing notice of a change in scope of the response for the removal action alternative previously selected for Site 5 at St. Juliens Creek Annex, Chesapeake, Virginia. Removal action alternatives were developed and evaluated within the Site 5 Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) Report, which was made available for a 30-day public review period beginning January 15, 2007. No public comments were received on the document. The EE/CA recommended Alternative 4 (excavation and restoration/wetland creation) as the removal action which was initiated in December of 2007. Discovery of munitions and explosives of concern at the site resulted in delays and the removal action has not yet been completed.

To allow for more flexible future land use, a change in scope of the response is planned to select EE/CA Alternative 3 (excavation and backfill) for the remaining portion of the removal action. The removal action, consisting of the removal of approximately 4.2 acres of waste and burnt soil and 5.3 acres of impacted surface soil and sediment, is detailed in the EE/CA report.
