The concentration of benzo(a)anthracene in sample SJS19-SB16 was only slightly higher than the dredge fill background UTL and was below the maximum concentration detected in subsurface soil during the background investigation, and is therefore likely indicative of dredge fill, as discussed in Section 2.2.
