John and I attended the EPA Vapor Intrusion Forum last month in Philadelphia. There was a strong consensus in the presentations concerning sampling that there was a lot of spatial variability in sub slab vapor concentrations and multiple samples would be required to characterize this vapor zone. My comment at this point would be to revisit the number of sub slab samples proposed for the various buildings and require a minimum of two or three samples for any particular building.

I have no additional comments at this time.
