Record of Decision Available
for Site 11 – Bone Yard (EPA Operable Unit 5)
Naval Weapons Station Yorktown, Cheatham Annex

The U.S. Department of the Navy (Navy) announces the availability of the Record of Decision (ROD) for Site 11, located at Naval Weapons Station (WPNSTA) Yorktown, Cheatham Annex, Williamsburg, Virginia. The ROD documents the Navy's cleanup plan for Site 11, which consists of no further action, and the basis for selecting this action.

The Site 11 ROD was issued jointly between the Navy and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and was reviewed and agreed to by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality.

A public comment period on the proposed remedial action plan was held between April 18 and June 1, 2010. Final signature for the Site 11 ROD was completed on August 31, 2010. The ROD for Site 11 describes the basis for the decision, including a transcript of the public meeting held on May 27, 2010, to take public comments prior to making the decision. All public comments were considered in a Responsiveness Summary incorporated into the ROD. No questions or comments were received from the public and the action selected for Site 11 was No Further Action.

The ROD will be available for public viewing for 30 days in the WPNSTA Yorktown Information Repository in the York County Public Library at 8500 George Washington Memorial Highway, Yorktown, VA

A copy of the ROD and all documents that formed the basis for selection of the action are available in the Administrative Record file.
