Proposed Plan for Site 11 – The Bone Yard Naval Weapons Station Yorktown, Cheatham Annex

The Department of the Navy invites public comment on the Site 11 (The Bone Yard) Proposed Plan that presents information pertaining to proposed final clean-up alternative at Naval Weapons Station (WPNSTA) Yorktown, Cheatham Annex (CAX) located in Williamsburg, Virginia. Site 11 is an approximate 2.7-acre area, west of Penniman Lake in the south central portion of CAX. In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulation, 40 C.F.R. § 300.430(f)(2), the Proposed Plan presents assessments of risk to human health and the environment. The proposed final clean-up alternative outlined in the Proposed Plan is No Further Action. No Further Action was selected based on the completion of a removal action that has eliminated all potential human health and ecological risks. Because there are no unacceptable risks, evaluation of action alternatives was not necessary.

The Proposed Plan is based on findings contained in documents that are part of the Administrative Record for CAX. The Administrative Record provides background information on Site 11, as well as remedial investigations conducted at the site.
