Naval Weapons Station Yorktown**

The Department of the Navy invites public comments on the Site 32 (Wetlands Area Downgradient of Beaver Pond), Proposed Plan that presents information pertaining to proposed final clean-up alternatives for surface water and sediment at this site at Naval Weapons Station (WPNSTA) Yorktown located in Yorktown, Virginia. Site 32 is the current wetlands area downgradient of Beaver Pond. Located in the extreme eastern portion of WPNSTA Yorktown, the centerline of Site 32 represents the boundary between WPNSTA Yorktown and the National Park Service Colonial National Historic Park.

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulation, 40 C.F.R. § 300.430(f)(2), the Proposed Plan presents an assessment of risk to human health and the environment. The proposed final clean-up alternative for the site outlined in the Proposed Plan is No Further Action. No Further Action was selected based on a review of site data that demonstrates there are no unacceptable risks to human health or the environment from unlimited use and unrestricted exposure to surface water or sediment at the site. Because there are no unacceptable risks, evaluation of further action alternatives was not necessary.

The Proposed Plan is based on findings contained in documents that are part of the Administrative Record for WPNSTA Yorktown. The Administrative Record provides background information on Site 32, as well as remedial investigations conducted at each site. The Proposed Plans may be viewed at the following location from February 20, 2011 through April 5, 2011 during normal business hours:
