**Proposed Plan for All Environmental Media
for Site 30 – The Bracken Road Incinerator
Naval Weapons Station Yorktown**

The Department of the Navy invites public comment on the Site 30 (The Bracken Road Incinerator) Proposed Plan that presents information pertaining to proposed final clean-up alternatives for soil, groundwater, sediment, and surface water at this site at Naval Weapons Station (WPNSTA) Yorktown located in Yorktown, Virginia. Site 30 is a former incinerator located in the western most portion of WPNSTA Yorktown next to the York River. In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulation, 40 C.F.R. § 300.430(j)(2), the Proposed Plan presents assessments of risk to human health and the environment. The proposed final clean-up alternative for the site outlined in the Proposed Plan is No Further Action. No Further Action was selected based on a review of site data that demonstrates there are no unacceptable risks to human health or the environment from unlimited use and unrestricted exposure to soil, groundwater, sediment, or surface water at the site. Because there are no unacceptable risks, evaluation of further action alternatives was not necessary.

The Proposed Plan is based on findings contained in documents that are part of the Administrative Record for WPNSTA Yorktown. The Administrative Record provides background information on Site 30, as well as remedial investigations conducted at the site.
