1. Enclosure (1) is forwarded for action required by NAVWPNSIA YORKTOWN.
Specific requirements include:

a. Complete cessation of disposal at the site; and

b. Two feet of final cover, graded to drain without erosion, site security via fence, gate, or other control, and establishment of vegetative cover.

2. Required compliance dates are 30 Jun 1983 for termination of site use, and 30 Dec 1983 for final closure.

3. Request written notification to this Command of completion of items 1.a. and 1.b. above so that proper response can be made to the State Health Department.

Dear Mr. Bailey:

As June 30, 1983 draws near, the time for bringing your solid waste disposal facility into compliance with State Health Department Rules and Regulations Governing the Disposal of Solid Waste becomes even more critical.

Again, this letter is intended to remind you that operation of your solid waste disposal facility after June 30, 1983, without a valid permit from the State Health Commissioner will constitute a violation of Article 3, Title 32.1, Section 32.1-180(A)(1) of the Code of Virginia, 1950 as amended, and will be referred to the Office of the Attorney General for legal action as authorized by Section 32.1-27(B) of the Code
