Dear Mrs. Norton:

In accordance with the schedule set forth in the above-referenced CTO and the modification request dated April 22, 1994, Baker Environmental, Inc. (Baker) is pleased to provide you two copies of the Draft Final Master Project Plans and the Site-Specific Project Plans for Sites 6, 7, 12, 16, SSA 16, and Background for your final review. Please note that two copies have been sent to the Naval Weapons Station Yorktown (WPNSTA Yorktown), four copies have been sent to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Region III, and two copies have been sent to the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ). In addition, one copy has been sent to each member of the Technical Review Committee (TRC) for their review and comment. A copy of the letter sent to the TRC members and a TRC member list is enclosed.

At your request, responses to comments on these documents have been sent to you for transmittal to the Agencies and TRC members as appropriate. This includes responses to comments submitted in early March by USEPA Region III, VDEQ, and TRC members, and responses to a second set of comments submitted by USEPA Region III on April 12, 1994.

Note that the Draft Final Master Project Plans enclosed herein are not provided in binders, in accordance with the contract. Rather, replacements for the Master Work Plan, Master Field Sampling Plan, Master Quality Assurance Project Plan, and the Master Health and Safety Plan are provided. Blue pages separate each document; these correspond to the tab pages present in the Draft document. Also enclosed are new cover/spine sets to place in the existing three ring binders.

In accordance with the comments, a few changes were made to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) volume included with the Draft document. Replacement pages are included in this package for the following SOPs:



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- * F103 - Monitoring Well Installation
- * F105 - Surface Water and Sediment Sample Acquisition
- * F301 - Sample Preservation and Handling

In addition, two new SOPs were developed as requested and are included herein. These SOPs are:

- * F109 - Environmental On-Site Test Kit Sampling
- * F210 - Seepage Meter

As you are aware, these Draft Final documents are being submitted nearly one month behind the schedule set forth in the 1994/1995 Site Management Plan because of unresolved questions raised by USEPA Region III which necessitated a second round of comments. As set forth in the Federal Facilities Agreement, USEPA and VDEQ have 30 days in which to provide any additional comments. If no comments are received, these documents become final and will be issued as such. A concurrence letter from USEPA and VDEQ should be sent to you acknowledging their acceptance of the plans. Baker does not anticipate that additional comments will be received, and therefore the field activities, originally scheduled to begin on July 5, 1994, will remain on schedule. If comments are received, the field activities may have to be delayed until the comments are addressed and resolved.
