I have reviewed the Contamination Assessment Report (CAR) Addendum dated March 1996 (received March 20, 1996), submitted for this site. I found all the documents submitted to date to be adequate to meet the contamination assessment requirements of Rules 62-770.600 and 62-770.630, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Therefore, you must now submit a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) in accordance with Rule 62-770.700, F.A.C. I concur that a No Further Action Proposal (NFAP) is warranted for the North Containment Pond Site and AVORD Perimeter Road Site. Furthermore, I concur with the recommendation for limited excavation of sediment and biomonitoring for the Gate 10 Dam, Alpha Dam, and the Possum Dam Sites. Finally, the proposed biomonitoring for the Aviation Ordnance Dam and the Gate 14 Dam Sites is acceptable. The RAP should detail the proposed limited excavation of sediment and the biomonitoring program.

Please submit the RAP to the Department within sixty (60) days. If you should have any questions concerning this review, please contact me at (904) 921-9991.


