I have completed the review of the Soil and Free Product Removal at Building 846, Work Plan Addendum No. 17, Naval Air Station Cecil Field, dated August 2003 (received August 19, 2003), prepared and submitted by CH2M Hill Constructors, Inc. The work plan adequately describes the work to be accomplished in remediating soils and free product associated with Day Tank 1 and somewhat associated with Site 57.
