I have completed my review of the Draft Site Assessment Report, NEX Gas Station, Former Underground Storage Tanks 880-6 and 880-7, Naval Air Station Jacksonville, dated July 2011 (received August 1, 2011), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The contour map of the potentiometric surface for the shallow zone of the surficial aquifer in Figure 3-1 needs to be redone. Contour intervals cannot overlap and several contour lines that could be depicted are not. Otherwise, the report is suitable for its intent and may be finalized. The data provided in the report supports the summary conclusions and recommendations put forth in Section 5.0. I also concur that this site should be transferred to the Navy's Installation Restoration Program where it will be designated Potential Source of Contamination (PSC) 56.
