I have reviewed the subject document dated August 26, 1994 (received August 29, 1994) and have the following comments for the Navy's/Air Force's consideration.

**GENERAL COMMENT**

Any references to FDEP's signature page should be removed. FDEP will send a letter of concurrence on the IROD from the Secretary's level. The Navy may choose to attach the letter to the IROD document.

**SPECIFIC COMMENTS**

- 1) Table of Contents: The Statutory Determinations page is listed as Page 10; however, Page 10 is missing from the document.
- 3) Table 1-2, Long Term Effectiveness and Permanence and Magnitude of Residual Risk: Please add a statement indicating that long-term monitoring of the stabilized soil is contemplated.
- 2) Statutory Determinations (Page 1-14): Replace it with Declaration Statement. Also, move the contents of Page 1-14 right after Page 1-4 since this makes for a smoother transition to the signature page.

- 4) Page 2-1, Site Name, Location, and Description; Second paragraph should begin with the following sentence:  
  
"The land use west of PSCs 2, 41, and 43, is primarily composed of a residential/recreational nature."
- 5) Page 2-1: Distances to residential areas should be provided in the text
- 6) Page 2-5: Add to the beginning of the second paragraph:

"On September 1991, Naval Air Station Jacksonville entered into a Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) with the USEPA and the former Florida Department of Environmental Regulation (agency is now named Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP)). The purpose of this agreement was to establish a procedural framework and schedule for developing, implementing, and monitoring appropriate response actions at NAS Jacksonville in accordance with existing regulations. The FFA requires the submittal of several primary and secondary documents for each of the Operable Units at NAS Jacksonville."

- 7) Add a table with a summary of the sampling results for all PSCs.
- 8) Page 2-5: Appendix A needs to be updated/replaced with the comments received during the public comment period.
- 9) Appendix A should begin as follows:

"The responsiveness summary serves three purposes. First, it provides regulatory agencies with information about the community preferences regarding both the remedial alternatives and general concepts about PSCs 2, 41, and 43 at Operable Unit 2 NAS Jacksonville. Second, the responsiveness summary documents how public comments have been considered and integrated into the decision making process. Third, it provides the Navy, USEPA, and FDEP with the opportunity to respond to each comment submitted during the record".

"The Focused Remedial Investigation/ Feasibility Study, Technical Memorandum, and Proposed Plan for PSCs 2, 41, and 43 were released to the public (update with dates), respectively. These documents were made available and an information repository maintained at the Webb-Wescoconnett Branch Library".
