Dear NAS Jacksonville Housing Resident:

This letter is to inform you that work has begun to clean up the contaminated areas in and around the Child Street area, located behind family housing.

Contractors are removing about 20 cubic yards of contaminated soil caused by previous dumping of equipment and parts containing radium. This area has been sampled and found to have readings above normal background levels but is not considered to be a risk to human life. The contaminated soil is to be taken to the landfill area for disposal.

Child Street will be closed periodically for approximately two weeks while construction crews dig trenches as part of the clean up process.

The bicycle path will be closed for approximately two months during the construction to prevent exposure to any contamination that may be present. Please, as a precaution keep your children and pets out of the fenced areas or construction sites.
