Naval Air Station, Jacksonville is currently proceeding with RCRA closure for two less-than-90-day HW tanks located near Hangar 1000. The closure is a requirement of Consent Order 88-0738 with the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation.

We request that this unit be added to our HSWA Permit as Hangar 1000 Underground Tanks, Site 46. Since the closure will be conducted in accordance with a closure plan approved by the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation, this site should be placed in a special category, not requiring an RFI because of the RCRA closure process. Additionally, this unit will be excluded from the Federal Facility Agreement procedures.
