Dear Mr. Sanders:

I have completed the technical review of the above referenced document dated December 2002 (received December 9, 2002). FDEP has the following comments:

- 1. Table 4-1:** The Action level listed for Arsenic is incorrect, 3.7 mg/kg is listed in the table and it should be 0.8 mg/kg. Action levels in this report should mirror the residential Soil Cleanup Target Levels (SCTLs), please correct and make sure all other Action Levels are also correct.
- 2. Page 5-1:** FDEP does not concur with the recommendation to propose No Further Action for the surface soil remedy at this time. As stated in comment 1, Arsenic's Action Level is listed as 3.7 mg/kg and it should be 0.8 mg/kg thus making this 95% UCL calculation incorrect.




