The Department has completed the technical review of the response to comments for the Preliminary Assessment and Site Inspection (PA/SI) U.S. Army Hawk Missile Site, Boca Chica, Site 25, dated June, 2011 (received June 07, 2011). Please note our comments listed below for this site.

- 1. General Comment:** Please note that the term Total Petroleum Hydrocarbon (TRPH) is not correct. The correct name is Total Recoverable Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TRPH). Please make the necessary changes to this document.
- 2. Page 4-1, Section 4.1, Groundwater:** This section describes several areas that could have served as possible sources of contamination at this site, both the generator building and the radar tower could have had chlorinated solvents on site. The Department feels that this information will need to be taken into consideration when conducting any future remedial investigations for this site.
- 3. Page 8-2, Section 8.1.3, Potential Contaminant Migration Pathways, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph last sentence:** This sentence states: *"At this time, it is not known if contaminated groundwater is discharging to any of the surface water features surrounding the Site."* The
