

**Subj:** INFORMATION FOR MARCH 4, 1995 RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD (RAB) SITE VISIT, NAVAL STATION MAYPORT

1. I have enclosed several items which will help prepare you for your Naval Station Mayport (NAVSTA) site visit this Saturday. First of all, there is a VIP pass which I hope gets you in the gate without any problems. Also, a map to show you where we will be meeting before the site visit - Building 24 at 9:00 a.m., ball park side of the building, park anywhere you see an open space, and remember - wear comfortable clothes. I have also included an excerpt from a document the Navy calls the "Blueprint". This is a "Draft" form of the document but I think it is still helpful in giving you a little more background on NAVSTA, the sites you will be visiting (map included, but hard to read) and the NAVSTA IR Partnering Team members. I will give you a larger map on Saturday so that you can more easily follow the "tour route". Also included is an extensive list of acronyms commonly used in the environmental program. And just in case you misplaced them or never received them, I have included Fact Sheets 1-3 which explain the NAVSTA IR program (#1), Interim Measures (#2) and the RAB (#3), respectively.

2. After the site visit we will meet briefly to discuss the agenda for the upcoming meeting on March 23, 1995 at 7:00 p.m. (I still need to check with the church for availability). I will also be handing out some additional information on the IR program schedule, a list of documents published to date, the Community Relations Implementation Plan, examples of Ground Rules and Charters, and last, but certainly not least, your very own RAB notebook.


