The Department has reviewed your August 9, 1995, letter concerning the contents of Tank 1380. Based on the information you have provided, the Department concurs with your conclusion that the contents of the tank is not hazardous waste. Therefore, you may dispose of the tank contents as non-hazardous waste.

Your letter also asked about the status of Florida's adoption of 40 CFR 273, known as the Universal Waste Rule. This rule is currently being "fast-tracked" by the Department for adoption, and will become effective in the near future barring any challenges to the adoption.
