RE: Clarification regarding the project status, "Remedy in Place"

Dear Ms. Wilson:

This is in response to your formal request at the last Partnering meeting for clarification as to when the Navy has satisfied the general classification of "Remedy in Place" and in doing so, defines the applicable media cleanup target goals for that project/site. This letter is written specifically to address project or sites at Mayport Naval Station which are being, or have been, evaluated under provisions of the HSWA permit for the facility. This question has been asked because several project studies had been completed, to the Navy's way of thinking, but the State of Florida subsequently requested that additional assessment or evaluation be conducted because the State media (soil, surface water or groundwater) cleanup goals had changed after the prior site/project assessment had been completed. When a site or project has been evaluated or assessed and the State of Florida concurs with a formal Statement of Basis for that site, then the site can be considered to have achieved the status of "Remedy in Place" and subsequent application of media cleanup goals, which may change after that date, need not be applied.
