

The Department of Environmental Protection concurs with the proposed final remedy for institutional controls, free product removal and Monitored Natural Attenuation for petroleum constituents as described in the Statement of Basis for the Mercury/Oily Waste Spill Area, SWMU 14, Mayport Naval Station. This site was investigated under the Resource Conservation Recovery Act Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendment Permit No. FL9170024260 issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 4.

Please proceed with the publication of the notice of availability of the Statement of Basis. Upon completion of the public comment period and satisfactory resolution of any public comments, the final remedy for SWMU 14 can be incorporated into a State HSWA permit.
