I have reviewed the subject document dated February 5, 2013 which was received on February 6, 2013 and was completed under Contract Task Order 0033. The report states that *"A Corrective Measures Study (CMS) has been conducted for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) 19, 26, 28, and 56 at Naval Station (NAVSTA) Mayport in Jacksonville, Florida by the Naval Facilities Engineering Command Southeast (NAVFAC SE) pursuant to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA)."*

The Introduction section of the report states that *"This report presents the results of the CMS, including the following:*

- 1) Determination of Media Cleanup Objectives (MCOs) using Chapter 62-777, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), and NAVSTA Mayport Background criteria (Tetra Tech, 2000; Tetra Tech, 2008).*
- 2) Selection of contaminants of concern (COCs).*
- 3) Determination of areas and volumes of impacted media exceeding the MCOs.*
- 4) Development, screening, and evaluation of corrective action alternatives.*
- 5) Recommendation of corrective action to address contaminated media at SWMUs 19, 26, 28, and 56."*



Based upon my review of the data, the screening of technologies and the assessment of the alternatives performed, the Department concurs with the recommended corrective measure alternative chosen for SWMU 26 which is

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Alternative 2. Alternative 2 involves implementing LUCs and maintaining the existing soil cover over the landfill.
