Dear Mr. Linton:

The Navy Initial Assessment Study (Equivalent to the EPA Site Screening Study) for NAS Memphis, enclosure (1), is provided for your information. The study determined that of 12 potentially contaminated sites, none of which pose an immediate threat to human health and/or the environment, five sites warrant further investigation to assess potential long-term impacts. A Navy Confirmation Study (Equivalent to the EPA Remedial Investigation Feasibility Study), involving actual sampling and monitoring of the five sites, is recommended by the study to confirm or deny the existence of contamination and to quantify the extent of any problems which may exist. The five sites recommended by the study for confirmation are:

- a. Site 3, N-121 Plating Shop Dry Well
- b. Site 7, N-126 Plating Shop Dry Well
- c. Site 2, South Side Landfill
- d. Site 4, N-121 Plating Shop Storm Drain and Sewer
- e. Site 8, Cemetery Landfill

It is our intention to initiate a Confirmation Study in the second quarter of CY 84. The A&E firm of Geraghty and Miller, Inc., Tampa, Florida has been contracted to conduct the study.
