
This action is being taken pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 68-46-212(d) which reads in part as follows:

The register shall record a notice that the property has been so listed. If the commissioner later determines that no further investigation, containment or cleanup is indicated at a listed site, the commissioner shall file a statement of this determination in the office of the register of deeds of the county in which the property lies. Upon receipt of any such statement, the register shall record the same. If containment or cleanup of hazardous substances occurs on a listed site, commissioner shall notify the register of deeds of such containment and cleanup and the register shall record the same."


