
In accordance with Section 120 (h) (4) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), as amended by the Community Environmental Response Facilitation Act (CERFA), the State of Tennessee concurs with the findings of no contamination on the properties identified as Facilities 246, 891, 1619, and 1739, on Naval Air Station, Memphis identified in your letter of 30 January 1995.

This concurrence is based on a thorough review of the information you provided in the Environmental Baseline Survey for Naval Air Station, Memphis in November 1994 and personal inspection of the listed properties by TDEC personnel.

We will continue to work with Southern Division to accelerate the turnover of property at NAS Memphis to the Millington Community and appreciate the effort that the Department of the Navy is expending in expediting the investigation and cleanup of these properties.
