

This letter is to inform you of the Division of Superfund's intention to initiate actions to remove the above referenced sites from the Tennessee List of Inactive Hazardous Substance Sites. This change is required pursuant to amendments to T.C.A. Section 68-212-206(e). The facilities will henceforth be governed by the RCRA Corrective Action Permit requirements. The Division of Superfund will continue its oversight responsibilities as designated in the Department of Defense and State Memorandum of Agreement.
