Phil Atkinson presented the results of the recent hexavalent chromium sampling event for the soil beneath the N-121 foundation. The sample from the southwest quadrant (130 mg/kg) exceeds the residential (30 mg/kg) and industrial (64 mg/kg) PRGs. The sample from the southeast quadrant (31 mg/kg) exceeds the residential PRG; however, it does not exceed the industrial PRG. The sample collected from beneath the concrete sump (8.3 mg/kg) was below the PRGs.

The team discussed the direction of the site with respect to the July 22, 2003, TDEC letter regarding the CMS Report. Roger Donovan stated that if he receives an extension request for the submittal of the CMS Work Plan that he would grant the extension. Roger Donovan requested that the CMS Work Plan be submitted as an "Interim Measures" report to speed up the process. The potential remedy will be to install more wells in the plume area and to use passive injection.

The BCT decided that SWMU 14 should use passive injection as a treatment remedy, similar to SWMU 39. This remedy will be detailed in the SWMU 14 CMS Report that will be submitted in late September 2003.
