John Stedman initiated the discussion by confirming everyone received a copy of the SWMU 3 Statement of Basis (SB) and also a Supplemental Risk Evaluation document. He explained that he was not looking for approval of the documents at this point, but rather wanted everyone to agree on the format and content of the documents so that they could be used as a template for future SBs. Charles Burroughs with TDEC said that the Supplemental Risk Evaluation document was not needed and TDEC did not want it included with the SBs. Ben Brantley explained the risk document was prepared to evaluate risks at the site using post-RFI data which was a USEPA comment on previous SBs. Charles Burroughs said that with the new Tennessee Groundwater Classification system the State does not look at sites based on risks, but rather a comparison of MCLs and Region 9 PRGs. He indicated that metals concentrations could be compared to background concentrations and metal concentrations that were the same order of magnitude as background samples would be considered background. He also said that if there is a MCL or Region 9 PRG exceedance then corrective actions are required for the site. However, corrective actions could be limited to institutional controls. Charles Burroughs explained if the background concentrations are higher than the MCLs or PRGs then the background concentrations would be used to determine if corrective actions are necessary. He said if contaminant concentrations do not exceed background concentrations even if they exceed a MCL or PRG, no corrective actions including institutional controls would be required. He said that in the case of metals in groundwater, TDEC would accept the use of filtered samples to help make this determination. Jennifer Tufts said the USEPA still looks at sites based on risks and wanted the evaluation included. Bill Hill also expressed concern with not basing decisions on risks. Charles Burroughs said that TDEC has RCRA authority now and that USEPA should send their comments related to Corrective Action sites to TDEC and they will take them under advisement. John Stedman asked about the Teaming Agreement between USEPA, TDEC, and the Navy. Charles Burroughs indicated that USEPA should only provide direct comments if the site is a BRAC site. The discussion ended with the understanding that USEPA and TDEC management would discuss the issue further.

John Stedman confirmed that everyone received the updated trend graphs and tables with the February 2005 groundwater results included. He stated that overall the results are positive. He mentioned EnSafe had obtained an extension from the Memphis and Shelby County Health Dept. to continue injections for another year at AOC A and also permission to add 7 existing wells within Sub-plume D (N-6/Vegetable Oil Pilot Study area) and one existing well (57LF) within Subplume A into the injection well network. The 7 wells were recommended in the AOC A Progress Report submitted in March 2005, but well 57LF was not. He requested that USEPA and TDEC send a letter or email of concurrence if they were ok with adding the 8 additional wells into the injection well network since this was a deviation from the Work Plan.
