The BCT continued the discussion from the previous BCT concerning the formats of the Statements of Basis. Jennifer Tufts stated that the EPA wants risk evaluations attached to the SBs. Roger Donovan stated that if the TDEC has already approved a site for no further action, then they will not likely revisit the site. John Stedman stated that EnSafe is creating a SB template that compares contaminants to regulatory standards (per conversations with Charles Burrough, TDEC, during the previous BCT meeting).

The BCT then discussed if the BCT should or should not be referenced in the non-BRAC sites. Roger Donovan stated that the BCT should be removed and that only the TDEC should be listed as the decision maker. Jennifer Tufts was concerned that the EPA's comments will not be included in the public record if they did not agree with the SB. Roger Donovan and Bill Crispin confirmed that a response to comments document would be prepared to address comments received from the public and USEPA. This document would be part of the administrative record.

The BCT decided that the USGS, TDEC, and EPA need to comment on the draft SWMU 3 SB that they received.
